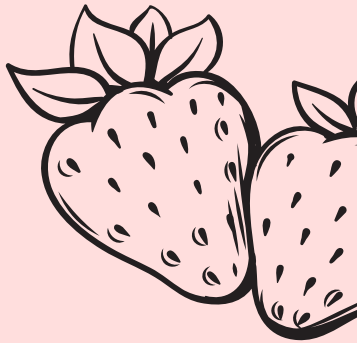


Crocheted Strawberry Hat

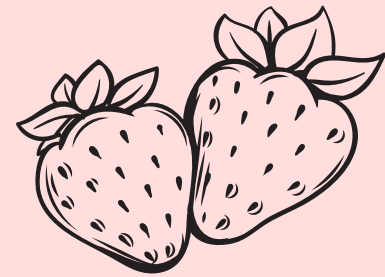


Capture the playful spirit of summer with this delightful Strawberry Hat, inspired by the iconic look of the little girl in *Squid Game*, Season 2. Designed for children, this lightweight hat is perfect for sunny days, keeping the sun out of little eyes while adding a touch of whimsical charm to any outfit.

This pattern is worked in two pieces: the main hat, shaped like a strawberry, and a textured stem for the top. The hat is made using simple and versatile half double crochet (hdc) stitches, creating a smooth and comfortable fit. The stem adds a fun finishing touch with a mix of single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), and double crochet (dc) stitches for added dimension.

Whether you're creating it for a little one or crafting a playful gift, this pattern is sure to bring smiles and summer vibes to your crochet projects. Let's get started!

Pattern Notes



The pattern is written for a toddler size. The finished size for toddlers is 7" across and 17" around. The hat is worked in two pieces (the hat and the stem) then stitched together using a crocheted slip stitch. The seed embellishments are the final touch and sewn in by hand.

Materials

Yarn - Hobbii Rainbow 8/4 cotton yarn, 50g, 160 m (fingering weight) as follows: 1 skein dark magenta, 1 skein emerald, 1 skein pink berry smoothie

Hook - size 3mm (US D, 3)

Other: stitch markers, large darning needle

Gauge - 21 stitches, 26 rows to 10 cm/4"

Skill level - intermediate

Abbreviations

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Hdc - half double crochet

Hdcbl - half double crochet in back loop

Tc - triple crochet

Sk - skip



Pattern

Hat

- 12 hdc in Dark Magenta
- 2hdc in each hdc (24 st)
- Hdc, 2hdc, repeat (36 st)
- Hdc x 2, 2hdc repeat (48 st)
- Hdc x 3, 2hdc repeat (60 st)
- Hdc x 4, 2hdc repeat (72 st)
- Hdc x 5, 2hdc repeat (84 st)
- Hdc around 10 times
- Work in back loop. Hdc, hdc2 around
- Hdc x 2, 2hdc repeat
- Hdc x 3, 2hdc repeat
- Hdc around



Leaves and Stem

Note: The stem is worked as a separate piece, and is attached later.

- Change color to emerald
- Ch12
- Sc in 3rd ch, 2sc, 3hdc, 2dc, 2tc (Do not cut yarn.)
- Repeat previous 2 rows four more times. This will create five leaves.
- Sc along top edges of leaves (2sc per leaf for a total of 10 st).
- Join to create a circle.
- Hdc around for five rows.



Finishing

Attach Stem to Hat

- Weave in loose ends on hat and stem.
- Use stitch markers to attach stem to hat.
- Working in the underside of the hat, secure the stem with a sl along each leaf.



Add Embellishments

- Using the Pink Berry Smoothie color and a large darning needle, sew in the V-shaped embellishments. Stagger the V stitches for an irregular look.
